- 3. Dorchester participants can come in to pick up emergency food bags ONCE A MONTH.
- 4. Patients of the Dorchester House who live outside of Dorchester or Mattapan will need to bring this EMERGENCY FOOD PANTRY REFERRAL FORM signed by your Dorchester House Provider for a ONE TIME USE. Patients will be referred to the Food Source Hotline to access a pantry in their city/town.
